Absolute Home & Garden Recommended Care for: Sump Pump

Please take the time to review the following information regarding your new Sump Pump. Maintenance is the sole responsibility of the homeowner. The following tips will help ensure that your Sump Pump is operating correctly. These steps should be performed every year to ensure that your unit is working properly. If something is not working correctly or for more information, refer to the Products Owner's Manual.

Inspecting

Start by checking the sump pit for any debris that could interfere with your pumps operation. Unplug the pump and take a look at the intake on the pump, and clean it out if necessary. Before you plug the unit back in make sure that the power source is working and inspect the cord for any evidence of wear or tear, animals love to chew on power cords. Once you have inspected the cord and the pit is free of any debris then plug the pump back in, and make sure that the pump is level and upright.

Testing

Add a few gallons of water into the pit to make sure that the float component is unobstructed and can move smoothly. If the unit is operating properly, when you add water, the float should rise with the water level, eventually triggering the unit to start pumping.
